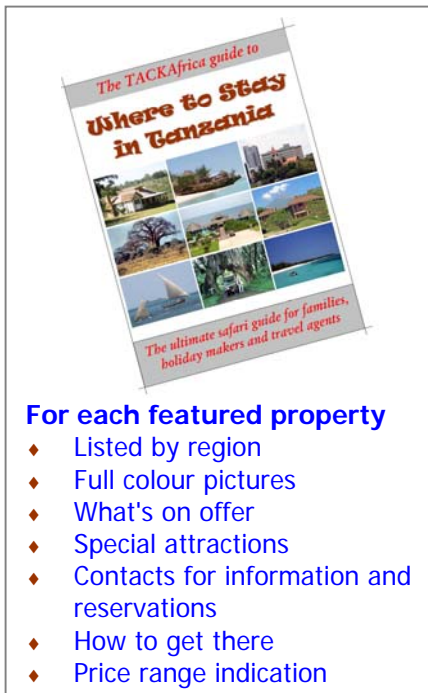


The TACKAfrica guide to **Where to Stay in Tanzania**

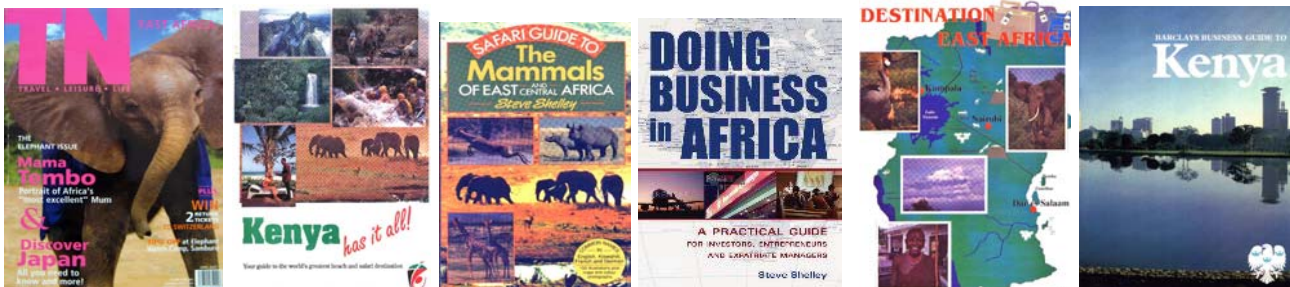
